the last of the 108 major treasure revealers prophesised by Guru Rinpoche is regarded as the universal monarch of all treasure revealers, being one of only two owners of the seven transmissions and the only tertön to reveal treasure teachings that include the Space Section of the Great Perfection (Dzogchen). The collection of treasures revealed by Chokgyur Lingpa with its related teachings are contained within 40 volumes in the Chokling Tersar (New Treasures of Chokgyur Lingpa). One of the main cycle of teachings in the Chokling Tersar is Lamé Tukdrub Barché Künsel (Accomplishing the Guru's Wisdom Mind, Dispeller of All Obstacles).

The main deities in this teaching—Guru Rinpoche, Avalokiteśvara, Amitābha, and Guru Rinpoche's twelve manifestations—are shown here.
